PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

NOTICE is hereby given that Doncaster Borough Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 because works are being or proposed to be executed on or near the roads and the effect will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in those lengths of Apy Hill Lane at Tickhill/Stainton Lane at Wilsic and Tickhill Back Lane/Lime Kiln Lane at Stainton in the Doncaster Metropolitan District as described in the Schedule to this notice on the dates and times referred to in the said Schedule

Reason for closure: To ensure the safety of the public and the workforce whilst works for the provision of specialist carriageway surface dressing and subsequent road markings are undertaken.

NOTICE is also given that the alternative route for vehicles affected by the Order is as described in the Schedule to this notice. Those residents and businesses directly affected by the works notified of the scheme and access arrangements.

The Proposed Order will continue in force up to and including the 31st day of August 2022 or until the works which it is proposed to carry out in or near the said roads have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

SCHEDULE

Location

- 1) Apy Hill Lane, Tickhill from its junction with Stoney Lane to its junction with Tickhill Back Lane
- 2) Tickhill Back Lane, Stainton from its junction with Apy Hill Lane to its junction with Lime Kiln Lane
- 3) Stainton Lane, Wilsic from its junction with Long Gate to its junction with Tickhill Back Lane
- 4) Lime Kiln Lane, Stainton from its junction with Tickhill Back Lane to its junction with Cockhill Lane

Dates and Times

On or after 1st May 2022 until 31st August 2022.

The roads will be closed on up to 5 separate occasions, with each occasion lasting no longer than three consecutive days. The works may occur on a weekend. This process is weather dependant and as such exact dates for each location cannot be given.

Diversions Route

1) and 2) Stainton Lane, Long Gate, Wilsic Road, Church Road, Wadworth Road, Doncaster Road, Northgate, Mangham Lane, St Marys Road, New Road, Pinfold Lane and vice versa.

3) and 4) Cockhill Lane, Long Gate and vice versa
