

**DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, DONCASTER)
(PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018
(AMENDMENT NO.) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that Doncaster Borough Council proposes to make an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order will be to:-

(a) Delete the following item from Schedule 1.03 - no waiting at any time:

Market Place Tickhill

West Side

(iii) From a point 96 metres north of its junction with the north western kerblines of St Mary's Gate for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction

and the following item was substituted in lieu thereof:-

(iii) From a point 96 metres north of its junction with the north western kerblines of St Mary's Gate for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction

(b) Delete the following item from Schedule 4.07 - waiting limited to 2 hours with return prohibited within 4 hours Monday to Saturday 8.00 A.M. TO 6.00 P.M.

Market Place Tickhill

West Side

From a point 43 metres north of its junction with the north western kerblines of St. Mary's Gate for a distance of 54 metres in a northerly direction

and the following items were substituted in lieu thereof:-

Sunderland Street Tickhill

North Side

From a point 15 metres west from its junction with the western kerb line of Tithes Lane for a distance of 16 metres in a westerly direction

South Side

From a point 20 metres east from its junction with Market Place to the eastern boundary of Nos. 5a Sunderland street

(C) The following items were included in Schedule 4.09 - waiting limited to 1 hour with return prohibited within 1 hour Monday to Saturday 8.00 A.M. to 6.00 P.M.

Market Place Tickhill

West Side

(i) From a point 8 metres north from the northern boundary of Nos. 2 Market Place for a distance of 25 metres in a northerly direction

(ii) From a point 43 metres north of its junction with the north western kerblines of St. Mary's Gate for a distance of 54 metres in a northerly direction

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods and in connection with building industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, for the collection and delivery of postal packets or if it is a vehicle being operated by or on behalf of the South Yorkshire Safety Camera Partnerships while carrying out roadside monitoring or enforcement operations. The usual exceptions for disabled persons vehicles will also apply.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the restricted road and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at (i) the Council Offices, Civic office, Waterdale, Doncaster between 8.45 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. Monday to Friday and (ii) The Central Library, Waterdale, Doncaster during normal opening hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing quoting reference number L/CP/68397 to the undersigned by the 25th day of April 2019.
