L01-20 | THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND POLICE AND CRIME PANELS (CORONAVIRUS) (FLEXIBILITY OF LOCAL AUTHORITY AND POLICE AND CRIME PANEL MEETINGS) (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 2020

Regulation 13 – s.1 (4) (a) of the 1960 Act has been further amended by the Amendment Regulations so it now provides that public notice of the time and place of the meeting and details of remote access by public and press to that meeting by electronic means, including by telephone conference, video conference, live webcasts, and live interactive streaming shall be given, in some central and conspicuous place in the area with which it is concerned, or publishing on the website.

Local Government Act 1972 three clear days at least before the meeting or, if the meeting is convened at shorter notice, then at the time it is convened. In NALC's view the effect of the amendment is that it is not enough to give notice of a remote meeting and invite the press and public to make a request for the access information (e.g. the Zoom link). This information must be provided with the public notice when that notice is given. **Councils should take account of social distancing requirements before deciding to put notices in physical spaces.: to approve**
