

**Advisory Committee of Tickhill Town Council

Tuesday 8th May 2018 - 7.30pm

Minutes

Present were: Chairman (Neighbourhood Watch), Deputy Chair/Clerk, Three members of the Town Council, 2 other group members (TOFG and Cricket Club/Lions)

1. Apologies were received from 7 other members of the group
2. Minutes of the meeting held on 13th March 2018 were agreed.
3. Progress Reports:
 - A planning application has been received by the Council from the agents of the Millstone for alterations to be carried out at the rear of the property. Application number 18/01080/FUL
 - There has been no progress on the alterations to the Neighbourhood Plan map.
4. Neighbourhood Management,
There was no report, other than there had been a promotion to the Operations Manager(O.M.) for a current employee to deal with street scene.
The clerk was requested to invite the O.M. to the next meeting to speak on his new role in the parish.
5. Road Safety/Traffic/Highways.
 - The road surface on St Mary's Gate has been renewed only to be dug up for emergency gas pipe repairs.
 - The article re alterations to parking has been placed in Tickhill Today and the Council has agreed to await until the end of May to make any further moves, giving the residents the chance to voice their opinions.
 - Parking at the end of Mangham Lane/pavement is causing dangerous conditions, as so is the parking of cars on the footpath in the St Mary's car park. Residents/motorists are requested to park with due care and attention at all times.
6. Environment.
 - The Yorkshire Wild Life Trust are to create a scrape in Tickhill Wild Wood to form a wet area to attract a more diverse population of wild life. Work on this will be carried out at the back end of the year.
 - The gates on Jubilee Wood have been replaced.
7. Neighbourhood Plan Implementation Progress
The council are making good progress on the History Information Board which will be placed near to the seats on the corner of Darfield house.
8. Members' items.
 - A request has been made to D.M. B.C. to reinstate Tickhill 4 footpath.
 - Doncaster Ramblers have a new programme of walks
