**Millstone application 19/01725/FUL PLANNING PERMISSION REFUSED.
STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH ARTICLE 35 OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY
DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE ORDER 2015**

In dealing with the application referred to above, despite the Local Planning Authority wanting to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive manner based on seeking solutions to problems arising in relation to dealing with the planning application, in this instance this has not been possible due to the reasons mentioned below.

The proposed development fails to provide a high-quality environment lacking sufficient and adequate landscaping contrary to paragraph 127 parts a) and b) of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF 2019) and Policy 49 of the emerging Doncaster Local Plan.

The Planning meeting was held via video link, and attended by Cllr: John Bergin who spoke for five minutes on the TTC objection, several residents and Councillors attended as observers.

A DMBC officer is to be contacted about the rapid site deterioration and safety issues relating to the Millstone site
